

This is an active mine regulated by the Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA). For your safety, you must follow the instructions of team members while onsite. Your unwillingness to follow instructions may result in your being asked to leave.

How to Get Material

1. Get your vehicle lightweight.

Pull on to the scale. You should be able to see your vehicle's weight on the reader board when you drive on to the scale. Tell the weigh master which material you need and how much you want. The weigh master will record your lightweight in the computer system.

2. Drive to the correct area to be loaded.

The weigh master will direct you where to go and will instruct the loader operator as to which material you want. Put your vehicle in park while you're being loaded. Do not leave your vehicle's cab at any time.

3. Return to the scale and checkout.

The weigh master will print a ticket with your lightweight, gross weight, and net weight on it. The ticket will show your total cost. After you pay, you are ready to go.

4. Keep your headlights on and use caution during your departure.

Mine Lingo

Scale House: also known as a "weigh station." This is where your vehicle is weighed.

Weigh Master: the official title for the person who records your vehicle's weight.

Lightweight: also known as a "tare." This is how much your vehicle weighs before you get material.

Gross Weight: how much your vehicle weighs after you get material.

Net Weight: how much the material weighs.

Leave your headlights on until you have left the graveled areas. Follow the speed limit. There may be narrow sections of roadway where you must stop or slow down and allow other vehicles to pass you.

Forms of Payment

Handpicking Large Landscape Rocks

If you are picking out landscape rocks, you will need to park outside the scale house and come inside. You will be required to review safety instructions and sign in and out of a log. You must wear a safety vest and hard hat to exit your vehicle. The weigh master can lend you a vest and hard hat if needed.

During your visit, a team member will escort you throughout the property. Follow the team member's instructions at all times. Do not leave your vehicle without permission from the team member.

Safety Rules

- Keep your vehicle's headlights on at all times.
- Do not leave your vehicle's cab at any time, unless you are going inside the scale house.
- If you have permission to leave your vehicle's cab, you must wear a hard hat and safety vest.
