We've compiled helpful information below to optimize your experience.

Helpful Tips

- Our minimum order for delivery is 10 cubic yards or 15 tons.
- We are typically 3–5 days out for delivery.
- The delivery window is approximately 4 hours
 - Morning: 8 AM–12 PM
 - Afternoon: 12 PM–4 PM
- Pricing is approximate. The final price is based on the truck's weight when loaded, and tax is calculated for your delivery address.
- We accept checks made payable to Washington Rock Quarries, which must be given to the driver upon delivery. We also accept debit cards and credit cards taken over the phone at the time of scheduling. We add a 3% processing fee on all card payments. Your card will not be run until delivery has been made.

How to Prepare for Delivery

- Make sure vehicles are moved away from the drop-off area.
- Do any ground prep work prior to delivery.
- Lay out a tarp where you would like the material dumped.
- If you are not able to be present at time of delivery, clearly mark the area where you want the material left.

King Creek Pit is a sand and gravel pit that produces soil, sand, and round aggregates like pea gravel, drain rock, and streambed material. The round rock is sometimes crushed into gravel.

Kapowsin Quarry is a basalt quarry where we produce crushed rock products like gravel and landscape rock.

When you arrive on the mine site, check in at the scale house, which is a mobile trailer. Pull on to the scale at the far side of the building. The weigh master will take down your information and direct you to the correct location to be loaded. Once loaded, return to the scale house to cash out.

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Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: Will the delivery driver spread the material?

A: The best the driver can do is a tailgate spread. He/she will try to get it as evenly as possible but there are no guarantees. Any more than that you will need to contact a landscape company or complete the project on your own.

Q: Can I mix materials in one load to make a minimum 15-ton delivery?

A: No, there is no way to divide the truck to accommodate more than one material.

Q: Can the driver place the material in more than one area?

A: Once the tailgate is open, the driver cannot close it and move to another area to drop the remaining material.

Q: Can I pay cash to the driver? How can I avoid the 3% processing fees?

A: We are a cashless company. We accept checks (without fees) or cards (3% fee).

Q: Can I pick up material myself?

A: Yes! We load material into the vehicle using a large loader, so a truck and/or trailer is required. Large boulders are loaded using an excavator. Be sure to have proper equipment to secure your materials, such as tarps, tie-down straps, etc. Our minimum fee for each load is \$35.

Q: Where do I go to pick up material?

A: We have two mine sites: King Creek Pit and Kapowsin Quarry. See "Visiting the Mine Sites" for more information.

Q: Do I need an appointment to pick up material?

A: Not unless you are picking up large boulders (Two-Man Rock and larger). We need 2–3 days' notice to ensure the boulders are readily available.

Q: Can I load my own material into bags or buckets?

A: No. Once you're on the mine site, you cannot exit your vehicle due to MSHA regulations.

Q: How late are you open?

A: The mine sites are open from 6 AM to 4 PM on weekdays and on Saturdays from 6 AM to 12 PM. The corporate office is open from 8 AM to 4 PM on weekdays only. When you are picking up material, please be in the pit no later than 15 minutes before closing or 30 minutes for large boulders. This will ensure you have enough time to get loaded and scale out before closing time.

Q: Can I have samples sent to me before I decide what I want?

A: We do not send samples in the mail. If you are local, you are welcome to come in and see samples of different materials. Call the sales office before visiting to give us time to prepare your samples.



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
